BIG 8'S MAY BE IN JEOPARDY!



Typically the club hosts 8 shoots on consecutive Monday evenings beginning on the first Monday in May and ending in early July, hence the name "The Big 8".

For many of us the Big 8 Shoots are the highlight of our club shoots. The challenge of shooting unmarked yardage coupled with the thrill of shooting 3-D animals makes these shoots the perfect way to get into hunting form. And for those of us who don't hunt, they give us a small sense of the hunting experience.

While these shoots are a lot of fun, they are also a lot of work to host. The 3D animals must be pulled out of the trailer, hauled out onto the course, placed and staked. Flags must be placed to lead shooters from one target to the next and marked for compound and Trad shooting positions. Since these are evening shoots, we typically provide a meal to our shooters. This means someone needs to prepare meals. Then everything needs to be picked up and put away at the end of the evening.

In past years, we've been lucky enough to have a crew of individuals who had Monday afternoon's available to do the prep work for these shoots. Unfortunately for one reason or another, our normal crew is not able to do this prep work. So if we want to continue to host our Big 8 Shoots, we need to find members who are willing and available to help do this prep work.

If you have a working membership and can be available Monday afternoons this would be a great way for you to get your hours in and help us continue this great tradition. At a minimum, we need at least two members each shoot to help set out the animals, shooting stakes and flags. We will have an experienced member to show our new volunteers the process, we just need more muscle to get the job done.
