


The Big 8: 4 More To Go





The Leroy Garner shoot will take place on September 22nd at 10:00 a.m. The event will include 28 3D targets at unmarked yardage. Two arrows for each target and shooters can purchase unlimited mulligans at \$1 a piece.

Our goal is to raise at least \$2,000 for charity this year, so let's get out there, enjoy the range, and support a good cause.

State 900

Mark your calendars! If you haven't heard, we'll be hosting the CBH/SAA State Target Championships "900 Round" on September 8th. Pre-registration is preferred, but it is not required.

The State 900 involves shooting 90 arrows at marked yardage:

30 arrows each at 60-50-40 yards for Adults
30 arrows each at 50-40-30 yards for Youth
30 arrows each at 30-20-10 yards for Cubs

Range Updates


Playground
